In compliance with California Senate Bill 2199, California Welfare and Institutions Code, and the California Penal Code, Adult Protective Services social workers are mandated to interact with specified law enforcement and other licensing agencies, and may, of necessity have to interact with others to assist in maintaining the safety, health, and welfare of Adult Protective Services clients.
