Instructions for Using Geodetic View:

Download the "Geodetic View.kml" file onto your desktop.

To open Geodetic View in Google Earth, double click on the Geodetic View icon.

To view documents, double click on the monument symbol. This will open a web minidatasheet. You will see links at the bottom for the datasheet, photo, and document (corner record). If the photo or document does not exist, the link will not appear. To view the documents, clink on the links. This should open the selected document.

To print the documents, first view and then select the "Open In Internet Explorer" tab in the top right corner. This will open the document in "GeoResearch" which you can then print from.

NOTE: When opening the document "Corner Record", you may see "Please Wait". Just select the "Open In Internet Explorer" tab in the top right corner. This will open the document in "GeoResearch" which you can then print from.

To search for monuments by GPS # or BM designation, you will need Google Earth Version 6 or later. You will find a search box located in the bottom of the "Places" window on the left side or your screen. Type in the designation here and Google Earth will search all of your kml files for the designation. After the point is found and highlighted, double click on the designation to view the point location.

When exiting Google Earth, always "Discard" the item in your Temporary Places folder. This will keep you from having multiple copies of Geodetic View in Google Earth.
